*Dr. Alfred Moldovan participated in the civil rights movement of the 1960's. Dr. Moldovan was the founding member of the Medical Committee for Human Rights (MCHR), which provided medical care and other health services to black communities eventually expanding their efforts to the political system. Dr. Moldovan was the lead physician for the marchers during the Selma Marches of 1965 and was Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s physician during the second march. In addition to being a witness to history, Dr. Moldovan is also one of the world's greatest Judaica experts and collectors.*
